The purpose of this role is to provide pathway opportunities for offending Rangatahi and their whānau who have entered into the Youth Justice system in Tauranga Moana.

This role is to assist Rangatahi in the development of their cultural knowledge and from a Ngāi Te Rangi Iwi approach, and to work collaboratively with Oranga Tamariki, Youth Justice Social Workers, New Zealand Police, Te Kooti Rangatahi the Youth Court, and other relevant agencies.
